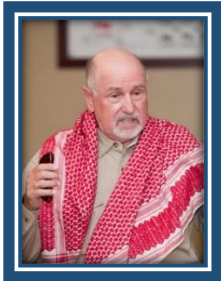




## The Fall 2016 DCFR Dinner Speaker Schedule

**September 20th (Tuesday):** Dr. Bard O'Neill, Dr. O'Neill served as Professor of International Affairs, National War College and the Director of Studies of Internal Warfare and Terrorism at the National War College. He has lectured extensively on the Middle East, insurgency, and terrorism and is a consultant to the U.S. State Department, Justice Department, Joint Chiefs of Staff, CIA and National Security Agency. He is one of America's foremost experts on terrorism and insurgency, author of the foundational book *Insurgency & Terrorism. On The Current State of Militant Islam.*

**October 13<sup>th</sup> (Thursday):** Dr. Michael O'Hanlon, senior fellow in foreign policy at the Brookings Institution, visiting lecturer at Princeton University, an adjunct professor at Johns Hopkins University and a member of the International Institute for Strategic Studies on *The American Hegemon in the 21st-Century: Change, Constraint and Challenge*. **Co-Sponsored by the DU International Public Policy Program (IPP).**
